A note before we begin...

If you are worshiping on your own today, or even with a small group of family members or friends, there will be some things that just feel awkward about this experience. Still, we are encouraging you to lean in, and try it out anyway. Everything gets easier with familiarity. As much as possible, read, pray, sing, and declare things out loud – for there is a spiritual power to the spoken word that we should never underestimate. You may find this strange at first – but again, the more you try, the easier it becomes.

If you have younger worshipers with you, please do your best to involve them in all aspects of worship. They are watching you and taking their lead from you. As you participate fully, they will also dive in.

If you plan to tune into our video teaching at the same time as others in our community (recommended) then you will want to begin your worship at home time at around 9:30am PST.

ENTERING WORSHIP

CALL TO WORSHIP

If you have one available, and feel safe doing so, light a candle and say these words aloud:

"We light this candle to remind ourselves that Jesus is the Light of the world, and He is with us always."

PRAISE & ADORATION

Take a few moments to do one or more of the following:

- Sing a hymn of praise accapella (suggestion: Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty)
- Sing a song of praise along with our <u>church Spotify playlist</u> (suggestions: <u>Our God</u>
 <u>Saves</u>, <u>How Great is Our God</u>, <u>Here I am To Worship</u>)
- Think of as many ways to finish this sentence as you can: God, You are______
- Write a letter to God, taking time to reflect on the nature of God and His faithfulness throughout this past week.

PRAYERS OF THE PEOPLE

Take a few moments to pray, lifting up your requests before God for:

- Your household
- Our Faith Community and Missions Partners
- Our Country
- The World

Open a Bible to **Psalm 42** and read it aloud.

BENEDICTION - A GOOD WORD

Say aloud:
